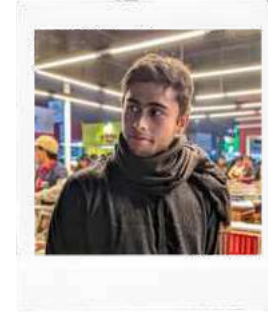

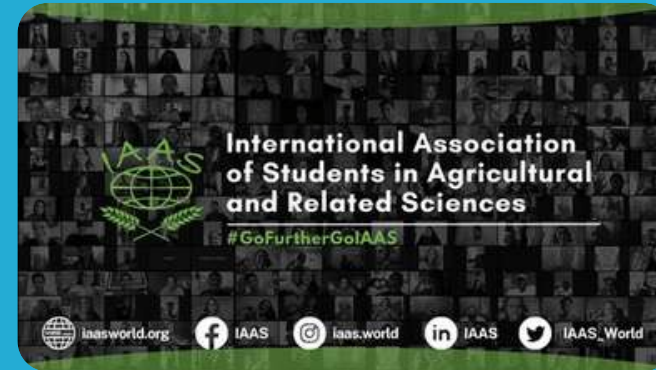

# What is the Exchange Program (ExPro)?

The IAAS Exchange Program (ExPro) is one of the core activities of the International Association of Students in Agricultural and Related Sciences, designed to provide students with international internship and research opportunities in agriculture and related fields.

With a legacy of over 60 years, ExPro has facilitated the exchange of more than 20,000 students worldwide, creating a global platform for learning, collaboration and professional development.

Through this program, students can participate in paid or unpaid internships, research placements and practical training in universities, research institutions, NGOs, farms and private companies across different countries. These experiences allow participants to gain hands-on skills, apply academic knowledge in real-world settings and understand diverse agricultural systems and working cultures.

By promoting cultural exchange, mutual understanding and international cooperation, the IAAS Exchange Program aims to empower young professionals to become future leaders who contribute to sustainable agriculture, innovation and global food security.

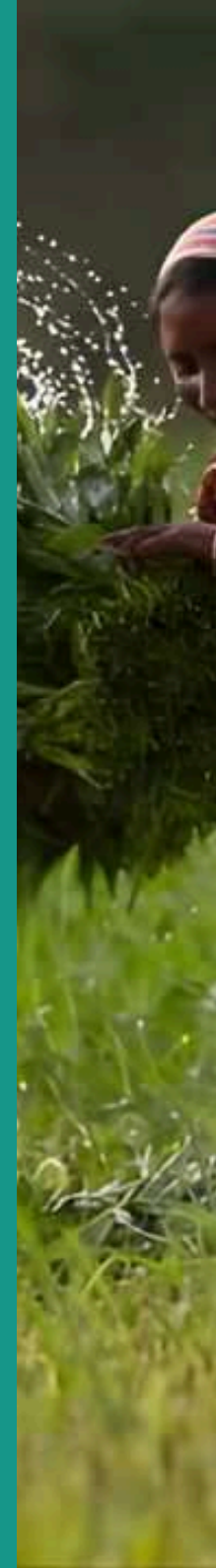

# Archimedes

Archimedes includes all internships that are not farm-based within the IAAS Exchange Program. It offers opportunities in professional, academic and technical environments.

## Areas of Work

Archimedes internships are divided into four main categories:

- Research: Work in research institutions, laboratories or universities
- Education: Engage in teaching, training or academic support activities
- Management: Involvement in marketing, finance, administration, or organizational tasks
- Engineering & Technical: Participate in technical processes, innovation, or ICT-related work

Libertas is a volunteer-based internship stream of the IAAS Exchange Program, focused on community development and social impact.

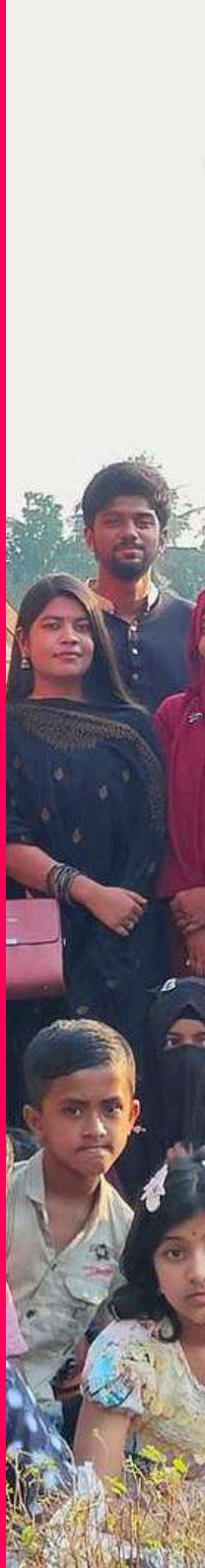

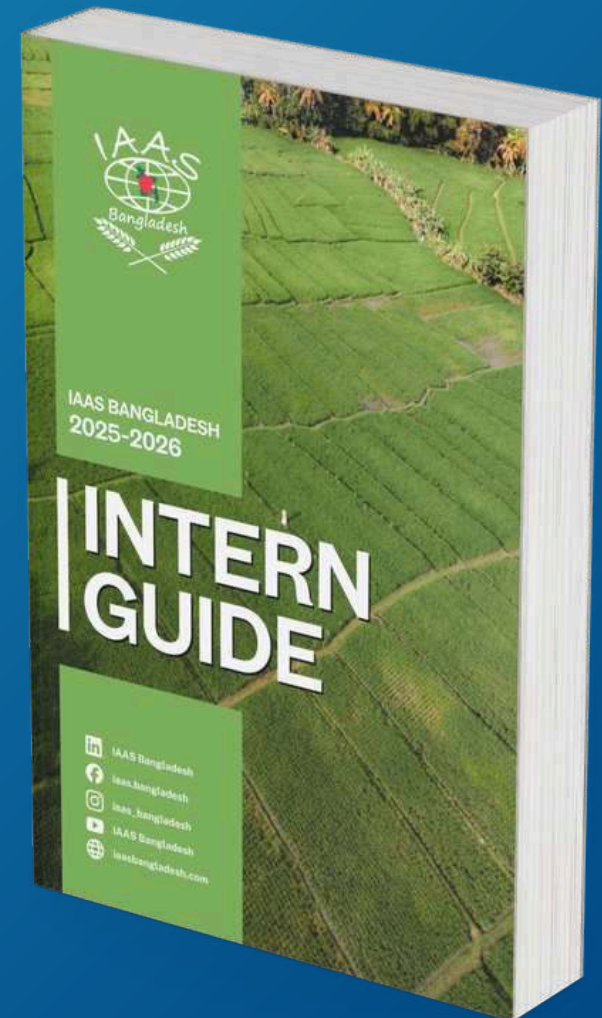
The Intern Guide is an essential document designed to support applicants throughout the Exchange Program process under IAAS Bangladesh.

## Job Description

As a volunteer intern at Ghashful, you will actively contribute to educational and community development activities while gaining hands-on experience in grassroots learning environments.

Key Responsibilities:

- Conduct regular classes and support educational activities for underprivileged children
- Assist in organizing and facilitating co-curricular activities (art, storytelling, games, etc.)
- Visit local schools & learning centers to observe & understand different educational settings
- Conduct structured assessments, including: Infrastructure conditions, Student attendance, Teacher–student ratio, Identification of learning gaps
- Design and implement “Fun & Learn” activities to enhance student engagement and creativity
- Carry out a Community Case Study, involving: Observation of a selected child or household, Monitoring attendance, hygiene, emotional well-being, and learning progress

**Interns are expected to follow the organization’s syllabus and adhere to all institutional guidelines.**
