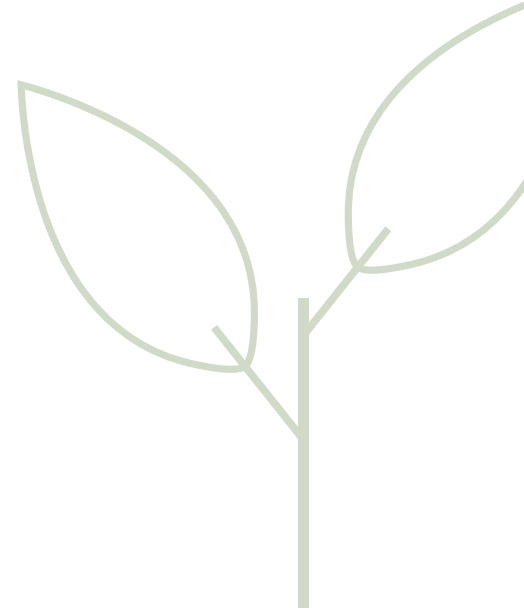

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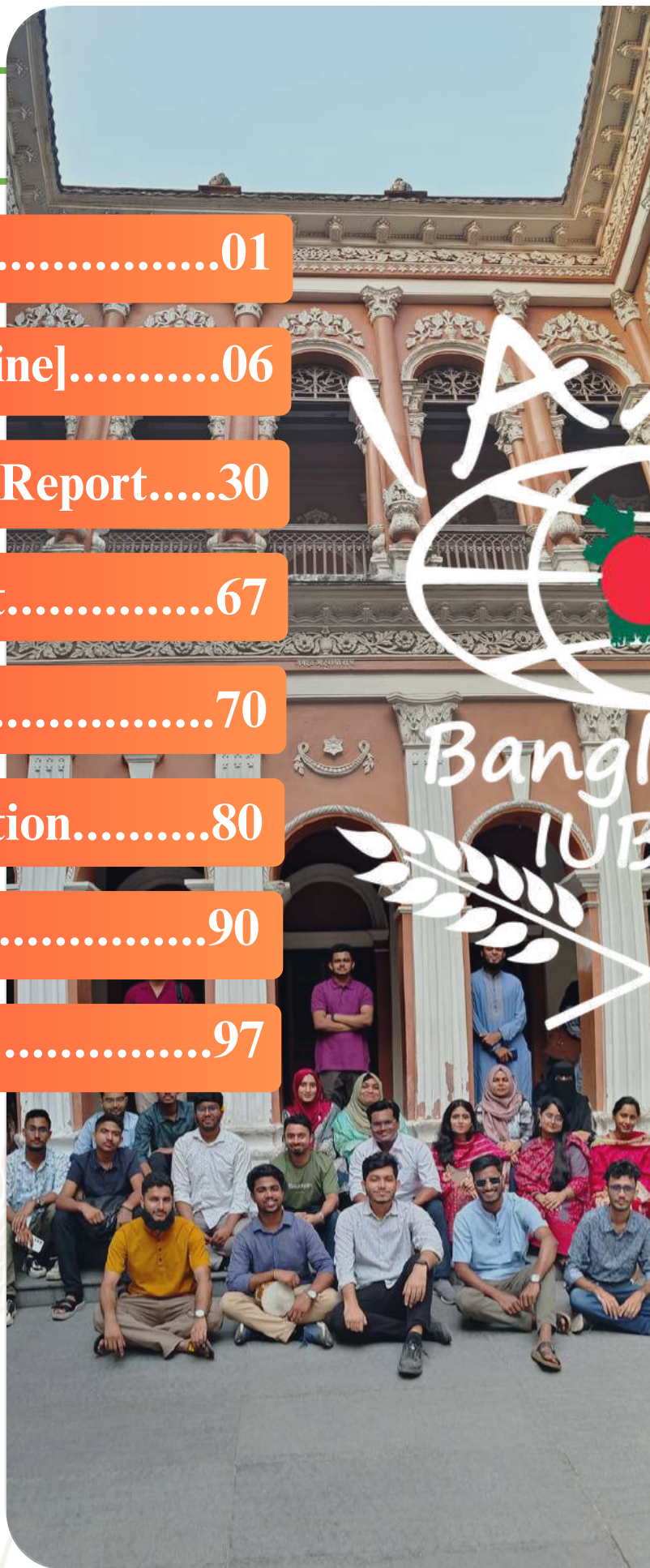
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Introduction

Foundation of IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT

The historical foundation of IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT represents a milestone in the evolution of agricultural student organizations in Bangladesh. While IAAS Bangladesh had long been a consortium of public agricultural universities, the integration of the International University of Business Agriculture and Technology (IUBAT) in November 2024 marked a paradigm shift by introducing the first private university into this national alliance.



The initiative was spearheaded on 14 November 2024 by eight visionary students from the BSc in Agriculture program, who recognized the urgent need to bridge academic theory with practical, youth-led solutions to the country's agrarian challenges.

These founding members—Rezwana Jahan Oyshe (LD), Roksana Alal Maria (VDF), Shahriar Mannan Imon Talukder (VDER), Md Atikuzzaman Shuvo (VDEx), Kamrul Hassan Rabbi (VDC), Shahriar Sabbir Tulon (HCB), Sourav Kanti Bala (RPDO), and Md Ahnaf Tahmid (MO)—established the Local Committee under the guiding principles of the IAAS Bangladesh Constitution. Their endeavor was formally recognized through an inaugural ceremony on 24 December 2024, solidifying IUBAT's place as the 16th national member of IAAS Bangladesh.

Recognized by the IUBAT Registrar's Office, the Local Committee is guided by a 10-member Advisory Board led by the Dean of College of Agricultural Sciences & nine distinguished professors, and supported by a structured student governance model, IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT continues to stand as a pioneering platform where innovation, collaboration, and sustainability converge to shape future agricultural leadership.

OUR UNIVERSITY IUBAT

The IUBAT-International University of Business Agriculture and Technology, established in 1991, is the first non-government university in Bangladesh and a pioneering institution in higher education with a strong focus on agriculture. The idea of IUBAT was initiated by visionary leadership of its founder Professor Dr. M. Alimullah Miyan in 1989 during his academic collaboration with Kansas State University, USA. His vision was to establish a non-government university that could address the nation's pressing need for skilled human resources, particularly in the fields of agriculture, food security, and rural development.



Since its inception, IUBAT has been committed to agro-economic development and sustainable resource management. Recognizing that agriculture forms the backbone of Bangladesh's economy, the university designed its academic structure to blend modern agricultural science with practical training. Importantly, IUBAT became the first private university in Bangladesh to introduce a Bachelor's degree in Agriculture (BSAg), opening new opportunities for students to pursue higher education in this vital sector. This program equips students with hands-on experience in crop production, soil management, biotechnology, agribusiness, and climate-resilient farming practices.

As a government-approved institution under the 1992 Non-Government University Act, IUBAT has continuously expanded its agricultural programs. Its BSAg graduates emerge not only as competent agricultural professionals but also as innovators and leaders capable of driving rural transformation.

Through education, research, and community engagement, IUBAT fosters self-reliance, sustainable farming systems, and food security—embodying Dr. Miyan's vision of transforming Bangladesh's agro-economy into a driver of national development.

Our Activities Offline

First Orientation Program and Inauguration Ceremony

Date: 24 December, 2024 / Participants: 50 / location: IUBAT Seminar Hall

IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT Local Committee held its official Orientation Programme, marking the formal introduction of our committee to IUBAT and Bangladesh. The event commenced at 1:00 p.m. with a recitation from the Quran and Geta, followed by the national anthem and a moment of silence in honor of IUBAT's founder, Professor Dr. Alimullah Mian. Our Local Director, Rizwana Oyshi, delivered the opening speech, introducing IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT. This was followed by Vice Director Shahariar Mannan Imon's presentation, which introduced our advisory board, executive board, and control board members, and provided an overview of IAAS Bangladesh, including its history, mission, and the future "Green Pocket" project. The event featured insightful speeches from our Advisory Board members, including Professor Dr. Khandakar Shariful Islam, who encouraged self-development, and Professor Dr. Abdul Karim, who emphasized agriculture's role in reducing carbon emissions. Dr. Sabur and Dr. Nizer Sultana offered guidance on excelling in academics and organizing innovative programs.



The guest of honor, Professor Dr. Ferdushi Begum, shared her thoughts on the future of biotechnology and generously donated to the Green Pocket project. The event concluded with speeches from our Dean, Dr. Shahidullah Miah, who emphasized youth leadership and opportunities in agriculture. Shahariar Sabbir Tulon delivered the vote of thanks, closing the successful event. The orientation program was a resounding success, setting the stage for collaborative growth and engagement. The event provided a platform for sharing IAAS Bangladesh's vision and goals, fostering a sense of unity and purpose among members and advisory board members.

Asia Pacific Traditional Food Preservation Documentary

Traditional Food Preservation: Where Cultural Heritage Meets Sustainable Resilience At the IUBAT Agriculture Research Station in Rajendrapur, Gazipur, IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT filmed a documentary titled "Ancient Wisdom, Modern Solutions: Sun-Drying for Food Security". This video campaign highlights traditional post-harvest food preservation methods, focusing on sun-drying techniques for cauliflower and tomato. The documentary was shot in collaboration with a rural farmer, Aduri Begum Anika, who demonstrated the process. The campaign aims to raise awareness about sustainable food practices rooted in cultural heritage. This documentary has been submitted to the IAAS Asia Pacific Regional Documentary Competition as an official entry.

LExPro: Educational field visit & Seminar at the BARI

IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT organized an educational field visit to the Farm Machinery and Postharvest Process Engineering Division of Bangladesh Agricultural Research Institute (BARI), Gazipur. The team was led by Prof. Dr. Engr. Md. Salim Ullah Khan Eusufzai, Advisor of IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT. Executive Board (EB), Control Board (CB), Quality Board (QB), and general members actively participated in the visit. The event featured three informative seminars focusing on postharvest technologies and value-added processing of mango, jackfruit, and other agricultural crops. The chief guest of the event was Dr. Md. Nurul Amin, Chief Scientific Officer of the division. Participants gained hands-on knowledge and valuable insights into the innovative technologies used to enhance postharvest handling and food processing.



Seminar on "Flow of The Delta: Mastering the Waters, Nourishing the Land — Resilience in the Delta's Ebb and Flow"

Date: 5 May, 2025 / Participants: 138 / Location: IUBAT Seminar Hall

IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT successfully organized a seminar titled “Flow of The Delta: Mastering the Waters, Nourishing the Land — Resilience in the Delta’s Ebb and Flow.” The event created a vibrant platform to discuss sustainable water management in delta regions, engaging students and faculty members in meaningful dialogue.

Prof. Dr. Abdul Karim, Professor of the College of Agricultural Sciences, delivered the welcome speech. A featured presentation on “Drought Conditions of the Delta Region and Water Management for Agricultural Production” was given by Dr. A.J.M. Sirajul Karim, Chair and Professor of the College of Agricultural Sciences.



The keynote address was delivered by Mr. David Mornout, former National Director of IAAS Netherlands and Program Manager of Water & Land Management at MetaMeta. His keynote highlighted the importance of sustainable and integrated water strategies for agricultural resilience across the delta region.

The seminar concluded by emphasizing the urgent need for resilience in water management systems and offering valuable insights into the challenges and opportunities faced in managing delta resources.

Ratnavandar: Bangladesh National Herbarium Educational visit & workshop

Date: 24 July, 2025 / Participants: 45 / Location: Bangladesh National Herbarium, Mirpur, Dhaka

IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT organized an educational visit, seminar, and workshop in collaboration with the Bangladesh National Herbarium under the Ratnavandar Project, with a special focus on the development of the Weed Herbarium segment. The program provided participants with both theoretical knowledge and hands-on experience in herbarium science. The seminar session was conducted by Sardar Nasir Uddin, Chief Scientific Officer of Bangladesh National Herbarium, who shared insights into the principles and importance of herbarium science. Following this, a technical workshop on herbarium sheet preparation was facilitated by Dr. Mahbuba Sultana, Senior Scientific Officer, offering participants practical training in scientific methods of specimen preservation.

Participants also explored the extensive Herbarium Museum, home to over 25,000 plant specimens, through a guided session led by Syeda Shahrina Hasin, Scientific Officer. This segment gave students a deeper understanding of plant biodiversity and conservation efforts.

LExPro: Educational Visit to Bhawal National Park

Date: 31 July, 2025 / Participants: 100 / Location: Bhawal National Park, Gazipur, Dhaka

IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT, in collaboration with the College of Agricultural Sciences, organized an educational visit to Bhawal National Park. The visit was supervised by Prof. Dr. Md. Abdul Karim, Course Instructor of Plant Ecology and Crop Climatology, along with Dr. Swapan Kumar Roy, who guided and supported the students throughout the field activities.

Bhawal National Park is a protected area renowned for its rich biodiversity and unique ecosystem. The park, covering a vast natural forest area, provides habitat for a wide range of wildlife including deer, monkeys, and numerous bird species. Established with the aim of conserving the natural environment, the park plays an important role in protecting the flora and fauna of the region.

During the field visit, participants explored the forest ecosystem, observed various species of trees and animals, and studied their interactions within the environment. The trip provided an enjoyable yet highly informative learning experience, bridging theoretical knowledge with field-level practical understanding.



LExPro: Educational Visit to Central Cattle Breeding and Dairy Farm

Date: 21 August, 2025 / Participants: 63 / Location: Central Cattle Breeding and Dairy Farm, Savar, Dhaka

The visit began with an introductory session at the Administration Section, where Md. Mostafizur Rahman, Animal Production Officer, provided a detailed briefing on the history, achievements, and operations of the farm.

Next, participants visited the BYER Section, guided by Runu Rani Roy, Animal Breeder, who explained the management of breeding stock and the importance of improved cattle breeds for sustainable livestock development. Md. Saiful Islam, Buyer Officer, also shared insights on the farm's buyer operations and livestock trade management.

In the Veterinary Section, Dr. Ashraf Hossain, Veterinary Surgeon, introduced students to the farm's animal healthcare facilities, disease prevention measures, and modern approaches to maintaining herd health.

The tour concluded at the Bangladesh Central Artificial Insemination Laboratory, where Dr. Rashed, AI Section Officer, demonstrated artificial insemination practices and explained their critical role in improving cattle genetics and productivity in Bangladesh.

Through this visit, participants not only gained exposure to advanced livestock management but also enhanced their understanding of breeding technologies and sustainable animal production practices.



AI Magic Marvel: Exploring Artificial Intelligence in Agriculture and Innovation

Date: 4 September, 2025 / Participants: 35 / Location: Abedin Tower, Banani, Dhaka

A 35-member group from IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT attended the AI Magic Marvel seminar, organized in collaboration with Skill Zen. The session featured Mondip Gharai, Secretary, National Housing Authority and AI Mentor, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, and RJ Shanto, Founder & CEO of Voice Factory Bangladesh, who introduced students to the practical world of Artificial Intelligence.

The speakers simplified AI concepts, demonstrating real-world applications in industries, agriculture, and data-driven farming. Highlights included discussions on AI's role in smarter food production, sustainable agritech solutions, and innovation-driven careers. Participants engaged in live interactions, gaining insights into AI technologies and their impact on agriculture, business, and sustainability. The seminar enhanced members' understanding of AI applications and inspired exploration of technology-driven agricultural solutions.

Date: 23 November 2025 / Participants: 88 / Location: Google Meet (Online)

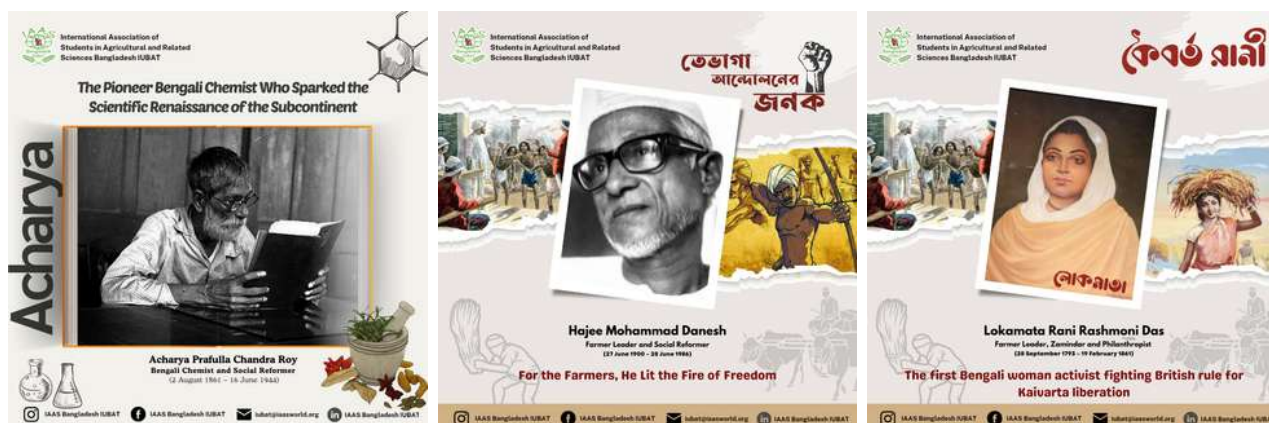

Project Ratnavandar

Preserving Nature's Legacy, One Specimen at a Time.

The Ratnavandar Project is a visionary herbarium and agricultural biodiversity conservation initiative launched by IAAS Bangladesh IUBAT to preserve and document the rich agro-ecological heritage of Bangladesh. The project focuses on the systematic collection of soil samples, weeds, and indigenous crop seeds from all 30 Agro-Ecological Zones (AEZs) of the country. Through this effort, Ratnavandar aims to create a comprehensive repository that reflects the diversity, resilience, and scientific importance of Bangladesh's agricultural ecosystems. The initiative serves as both a conservation and educational platform by preserving traditional agricultural knowledge, native crop varieties, and ecological resources that are increasingly threatened by climate change, biodiversity loss, and soil degradation. Ratnavandar is envisioned as a long-term research and educational resource for students, researchers, agriculturists, and environmental professionals, encouraging innovation and sustainable agricultural practices.

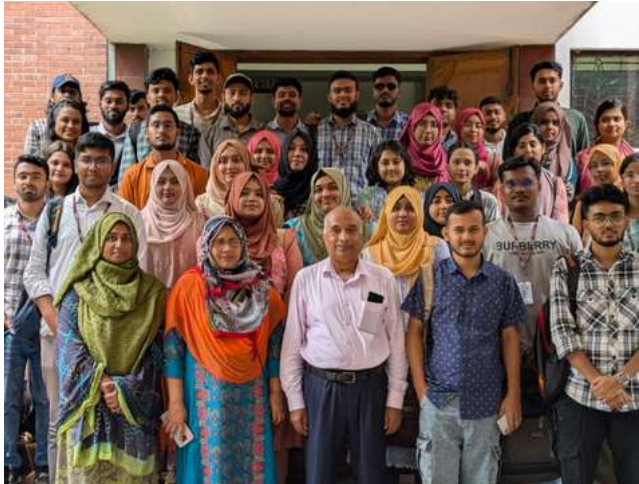
The project also emphasizes scientific documentation and interdisciplinary collaboration. By integrating traditional agricultural wisdom with modern research approaches, Ratnavandar contributes to the development of climate-resilient food systems and sustainable farming solutions. The herbarium is designed not only as a database of preserved specimens but also as a living archive that inspires future generations to value and protect Bangladesh's agricultural legacy.

A major milestone of the project was the "Ratnavandar: Bangladesh National Herbarium Educational Workshop," held on 24 July 2025 at the Bangladesh National Herbarium in Mirpur, Dhaka, with participation from 45 students and young agriculturists. Organized in collaboration with the Bangladesh National Herbarium and the College of Agricultural Sciences, IUBAT, the program focused particularly on the development of the Weed Herbarium segment. The workshop included a seminar conducted by Sardar Nasir Uddin, Chief Scientific Officer of Bangladesh National Herbarium, who introduced participants to herbarium science and biodiversity conservation.

A hands-on technical session on herbarium sheet preparation was facilitated by Dr. Mahbuba Sultana, Senior Scientific Officer, providing practical training in specimen preservation techniques. Participants also explored the Herbarium Museum containing over 25,000 preserved plant specimens under the guidance of Syeda Shahrina Hasin, Scientific Officer.

Project Jagoroni

Empowering Women of Rural Communities through Value-Added Mango Products and Eco-Friendly Farming Practices.

Project Jagoroni is a community-centered rural development initiative designed to empower women, reduce agricultural waste, and promote sustainable environmental practices in Bashkopa village of Gazipur, Bangladesh. The project was developed under the Women in Agriculture (WIA) and Village Concept Project (VCP) frameworks of IAAS, focusing on improving livelihoods through agro-processing, climate-smart farming, and environmental restoration.

Bashkopa village is naturally rich in agricultural resources and is surrounded by mango and jackfruit orchards along the Chilai River. During a field survey conducted on April 10, 2025, the project team identified several critical challenges affecting local farmers and women. Most mango trees in the area are 30–40 years old traditional varieties, which are highly vulnerable to pest infestation and post-ripening losses. In addition, Gazipur, known as the jackfruit capital of Bangladesh, suffers from severe post-harvest losses where nearly 45% of jackfruit production is wasted due to oversupply, poor storage, weak market linkage, and unfair pricing.

The Chilai River, once an important natural resource for the community, is now heavily polluted and blocked by invasive water hyacinth, reducing water flow and affecting the local ecosystem. Farmers in the area also rely excessively on chemical fertilizers and pesticides because of limited knowledge of sustainable agricultural methods, increasing production costs while harming soil health and biodiversity.

To address these issues, Project Jagoroni aims to train rural women in producing value-added products such as mango bars, pickles, jackfruit chips, and traditional ready-to-cook food items. These activities will create income opportunities, strengthen entrepreneurship, and enhance women's participation in agriculture and community leadership.

The project will also organize workshops and training programs on climate-smart agriculture, integrated pest management (IPM), vermicomposting, and eco-friendly compost production using water hyacinth. Alongside agricultural activities, community-driven campaigns will be conducted to restore the Chilai River through cleaning initiatives and environmental awareness programs.

By integrating women's empowerment, sustainable farming, and environmental conservation, Jagoroni serves as a grassroots model for resilient rural development while contributing to multiple Sustainable Development Goals including Zero Hunger, Gender Equality, Climate Action, and Responsible Consumption.
